MALIDA LADIES CELEBRATION ON JANUARY 13:

Join in an Indian Jewish celebration in honor of Elijah the Prophet and on the occasion of the Rebbetzin's birthday. This is a lovely Bene Yisrael event. The Malida refers to a particular type of food – a home-made, sweet, dessert delicacy that consists of pieces of rice bread made with sweet poha that are smeared thickly with syrup. A special, large, platter-like dish is filled with the malida concoction and nicely arranged, along with seven different kinds of fresh fruits, two of which should be new fruits. The dish is also adorned with flowers. Scented flowers or cloves are used for the "Besamim" blessing. After making blessings on the fruit, songs praising Elijah as the forerunner to the Messiah, are joyously song. Afterwards, many different blessings, quoted from the Hebrew Bible, are recited. The Malida ceremony is performed on happy occasions such as the purchase of a new house, the birth of a child, and a marriage. So come out and enjoy socializing with your friends, sample great Indian cuisine, and wish the Rebbetzin have a happy birthday ! Please RSVP with the office to confirm your attendance.
