MEMBERSHIP RENEWAL & HIGH HOLIDAY TICKETS:

As in previous years, the Shul will automatically continue to process payments for the new membership year unless instructed otherwise. **Membership fees have not increased**, and it includes free tickets for the High Holidays at any service / program for you & your children 25 yrs. and under. In addition, **we will no longer be mailing out High Holiday tickets to the service in the main sanctuary**. There will be a list at the door of members and people who purchased tickets to the main service. No need to bring any tickets - we know who you are. **All non-member ticket purchases to the family experience, taking place in the Moriah room, will be handled exclusively through Eventzilla**. Those people will need to bring their tickets which they purchased on line. Members are entitled to attend either the service in the main sanctuary or the family experience without purchasing tickets online. But you may only attend one of them throughout the holidays. Everyone may attend the Rebbetzin's alternative classes in the Moriah room. Tickets for non-members to the main service are \$200 pp. Tickets to the family experience are \$75 for adults & children 10 and older. Tickets for children under 10, attending the youth programs are \$50 pp.
