Dear Rav Yosef, shlita:

Shalom uvracha. Once again, with the arrival of Chodesh Elul, we have the special z'chut to participate in the ultimate Chesed Mitzvah by providing critical assistance for necessary foodstuffs for the upcoming Holidays to families of needy soldiers serving in IDF combat and combat support units.

Given the increasingly volatile security situation on both Israel's northern and southern borders, as well as in Judea and Samaria, many of our soldiers will not be home for the Chagim – especially those needy soldiers who will be on the frontlines risking their lives while knowing that at home their families will have, now more than ever, even greater difficulty meeting the financial burden of basic Holiday needs.

As I always write, these soldiers, serving in combat zones, risk their lives daily, and now even more so as the aforementioned security situation becomes more and more tense, performing their duty is all the more difficult. Many of them, due to their personal and family situations could easily get excused from military service, or at the very least, could be assigned to non-combat billets close to home. That these soldiers chose not to do so, and serve in front-line units says much about them. So the least we can do, is to give these brave young men the peace of mind that while they are out on the frontlines defending Israel and the entire Jewish People, at least their families will be able to have a Rosh Hashana, Yom Kippur and Sukkot Holidays as it should be.

In the name of these true heroes of our people, the young soldiers of the IDF, whose mesirut nefesh – both spiritually and materially - is an inspiration to us all, I thank you in advance for agreeing to be our partners in this most fundamental and crucial Mitzvah of Chesed.

As with previous Chagim, I am aiming **to provide basic assistance to approximately 1,000 needy soldiers and their families**. Thus, I am targeting the sum of **\$150,000**. to cover the various needs of these soldiers and other religious Holiday needs of the soldiers for these upcoming Chagim.

For those of you, who can still allot some of your Tzedaka funds for these truly deserving needy soldiers and their families, there are insufficient words to fully express my thanks.
